The event attracted a field of 62 individuals and teams. First home was one of Taupo's top Juniors John Glanville in 37m33s followed by Junior Alex Roberts 28 seconds later. Bryce Giddy was the first veteran in 37m33s with Shane Hancock the first senior in 40m33s. Senior Erin O'Hara was the first woman in 41m06s in 9<sup>th</sup> place overall. Ellie Heenan was the first junior in 48m53s with Anna Donovan the first veteran 4 seconds later in 48m57s. The Stutz and Shallcrass team were the first of 13 teams in 35m37s. There many Scenic Cellars spot prize winners with most competitors receiving a prize. The proceeds of the event will be donated to the "**Victim Support**" charity.

The next TriSport Taupo event on Monday 25<sup>th</sup> Feb. is the annual pre Ironman Splash & Dash starting from the yacht club at 6pm. This event for individuals or teams is a 500m swim followed by a 5km run along the lake front. A \$5 entry fee will be charged.
