Forty-nine individuals and teams took part in the Tri Sport Taupo Monday Triathlon at 4 Mile Bay. The Mainstreet Pharmacy sponsored event was over a 200m swim, 13km bike and a 2.5km run course. Junior John Glanville was first home in 34m18s with senior Erin O'Hara in 10th place overall being the first woman in 39m23s. The first senior man in 2nd place overall was James McGrogan in 35m09 with Chris Todd in 4th place the first veteran in 35m42s. The first junior woman was Nicole VanDerKaay in 43m11s with Anna Donovan the first veteran in 45m42s. Cameron & Sandy Todd were the first of five teams in 41m51s. The Mainstreet Pharmacy spot prizes went to Duncan Muller and Fiona MacDonald.
