

SCENIC CELLARS CHARITY TRIATHLON,
WHAREWAKA POINT, 19th February-07

The annual Scenic Cellars sponsored charity triathlon was held at Wharewaka Point on Monday night. The TriSport Taupo organised event was over a 200m swim, 10.7km bike and a 2.7km run course. The event attracted a field of 61 made up of 51 individuals and 10 teams. First home was one of Taupo's top Juniors John Glanville in 34m42s followed by Junior Cameron Todd 14 seconds later. Chris Todd was the first veteran in 35m22s with Jon Clark the first senior in 37m35s. The first woman was Junior Shea Reardon in 39m20s in 11th place overall with Jules Franks the first senior in 43m10s and Annabel Donovan the first veteran in 47m23s. The Top Gear Cycles team was first home in 32m46s. There were 50 Scenic Cellars spot prize winners with most competitors receiving a prize. The proceeds of the event will be donated to the "**St Johns**" charity.

The next TriSport Taupo event on Monday 26th Feb. is the annual pre Ironman Splash & Dash starting from the yacht club at 6pm. This event for individuals or teams is a 500m swim followed by a 5km run. A \$5 entry fee will be charged.
